Sharing Plants, Growing Community

The Woodstock Neighborhood Association has scheduled its annual pre-Mother's Day Plant Sale for Saturday, May 8th. Proceeds from this plant sale go into the Woodstock Community Center Maintenance Fund. Neighborhood volunteers provide routine maintenance for the Center as part of an agreement with Portland Parks that is keeping the Center open and available for use by the community. The Maintenance Fund pays for custodial service and supplies, chemicals for the boiler, as well as some landscaping needs.

The plant sale depends primarily on donations from many of the wonderful gardeners who live in our community.

Gardeners have contributed by potting divided perennials or seedlings that have

volunteered from plantings of previous years. Sometimes, as gardens are being redesigned, people have contributed plants they have decided to replace. Some of the plant categories we have been able to provide are perennials (many varieties), herbs, ground covers,



native plants, grasses, houseplants, and small trees and shrubs. Contributions for the plant sale can be dropped at the Woodstock Community Center, 5905 SE 43rd, on May 7th between noon & 7 PM. Any one who needs empty pots or an alternate drop-off time should call Terry Griffiths at 503-771-0011 .
